Ashadeep is rehabilitating homeless women/men suffering from mental disorders and children with developmental disabilities.

PRERONA, JORHAT

Prerona provides day care, residential care, vocational training, therapy for the rehabilitation and integration of the disabled.

RURAL VOLUNTEERS CENTRE, DHEMAJI

Rural Volunteers Centre (RVC) works to provide community rehabilitation services to the flood-affected people in several districts of Assam.

The year 2010-2011 was a busy but significant year for SESTAA. During the year 2010-2011, SESTAA extended its partnership with three organizations working in three different areas of Assam.

In Guwahati, SESTAA provided financial assistance to Ashadeep, for printing of training materials for staff and carers of mentally challenged children/ individuals.



In Dhemaji, a rehabilitation project for People with Disabilities (PWD) - individual assessment, therapy and assistive equipments and empowerment through formation of self-help groups.

In Jorhat, SESTAA has provided financial assistance for the engagement of one psychologist and one speech therapist for supporting the students of Prerona.
